Literacy

Year 3 have started their new topic all about diaries. We are using the book 'Diary of a Killer Cat' to inspire our writing. The children have started identifying the features of diaries and will soon be planning their own diary entry.

Year 4 are continuing with their newspapers topic. We are imagining that the Iron Man has arrived in St Neots and we want to write an exclusive story about what he has been up to.

Numeracy:

In numeracy, the children have been working on written methods for addition and subtraction. They have worked extremely hard to learn the column method. They have then put this into practise by solving tricky problems!

Year 4 are working hard on addition and subtraction and are using the column method with great success. We have also been checking our calculations using the inverse.

Homework

As you are aware, the literacy homework has changed. The homework will be given out on Thursdays at the latest and will need to be handed in the following Monday. Children will also have 5-10 spellings to practise each week.

There needs to still be an hour of Maths Whizz a week for the children.
