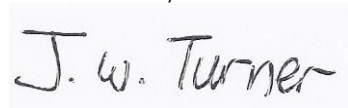
Parent Consultations – Year 6 Only

We are holding Parent Consultations on Tuesday 1st November and Thursday 3rd November 2016 for Year 6 only. This date is different to the dates for the rest of school due to Mr Browns planned paternity leave. This will provide an opportunity for you to meet your child's class teacher and discuss your child's progress. The consultations will be held in the school hall. **We would prefer it if children did not sit at the desk with parents during the consultation to allow all involved to have a frank and clear discussion without fear of upsetting your child with comments they may not fully understand.**

Please be aware that each appointment is 10 minutes long. Please do not be offended if the teacher stops the appointment after 10 minutes and asks that you make an additional appointment to continue discussions. It is really important that we adhere to the schedule and finish on time as I am mindful that staff will have been working since 8.00am and will continue to prepare for the following day's work after parents evening has finished. As with previous parents evening we will be continuing with the bell system, on the first ring this will indicate that your appointment with the class teacher is nearing its end and a second time to alert you that the appointment has finished.
