The ICE Zone...

The children have begun working on their R.E. topic work, based around celebrations, in the indoor ICE zone and have started to research information about Guy Fawkes to practise skills of retrieving information from different sources and presenting it in a new way.

Outside the children have been harvesting, and recording the statistics relating to the produce from our gardens as well as completing Autumn observation walks.

Willow Wonders!

The children are looking at stories with repeating patterns in Literacy, building their repertoire of stories they can retell. We started with 'Peace at Last' by Jill Murphy and have now studied 'Dear Zoo' by Rod Campbell. The strong story structure is helping the children to memorise the plots and enjoy adding sound effects and different voices in their retelling. In both cases the children have written sentences to fit the same pattern.

In Numeracy we have been counting forwards and backwards with sequences of numbers up to 100 and have now begun to look at finding one more and one less than a particular number. The activities are building the children's knowledge of the number system ready for exploring place value.

Cherry Champions!

The children have been studying the author; Anthony Browne. They have been enjoying learning about adventure stories and using interesting adjectives as well as similes.

In maths we have persevered with Place Value, the children are beginning to use this knowledge within their addition and subtraction.

Science has been great fun, looking at Living, Non Living and things that were alive once! We have learnt about 'Mrs Nerg' – do ask your child what each letter stands for that all living things do.

All the class are enjoying reading and I am very proud with how many rockets I've already been able to move.
