KS2 Homework

Dear Parents and Carers

This term the children in KS2 will continue to receive literacy homework once a week which will relate to what they have been doing in class. This will come home by Thursday at the latest and each teacher will spend time explaining what the children are expected to do each week. Children are expected to spend about 40 minutes on this homework, which should give them time to plan and write their piece of work.

As has been the case for a number of years in KS2, you and your child will be able to choose one week during the term to have as a week off. This has proved to be very helpful when families have particularly busy weeks, for example.

This year we are also going to start sending home between 5 and 10 spellings for children to practise at home each week. These spellings will relate to what they have been learning in their spelling lessons at school and the sheets enable them to have a practise of them each day. We will not be expecting these sheets to come back into school, but the spellings they have been practising will come up in their spelling lessons again the following week.
