School Arrival

Dear parents of year 5 & 6 students

Please can I remind you that school starts at 8.45am in the morning and the gate is open until 8.55am, giving children a 10 minute period in which to arrive. I know that children are keen to be on time for school so it is lovely to see children waiting ready and eager to come.

The last week or so I have noticed that children seem to be arriving at school earlier and earlier.

Looking out this morning, I saw some children waiting outside before 8.25am. This is too early for children to be arriving and to be unsupervised. If there is a reason that children need to be at school this early in the morning then we do run a Breakfast Club in school.

One of the main reasons that we ask this is because of how busy the car park can be in the morning before 8.40am, with staff and deliveries arriving. This is why the car park is closed at 8.40am to make it as safe as possible for the children as they arrive.

Please can I ask that you consider what time your children leave home in the morning so that they don't arrive any earlier than 8.40am.
