Literacy

Year 3 have been exploring persuasive texts this week. They have investigated the features found in magazine, TV adverts and leaflets. Next week, they will be focusing on letters before writing their own persuasive letter.

Year 4 are also focusing on persuasive texts! The children have just created their own persuasive leaflet where they used a range of features such as rhetorical questions, the power of 3 and imperative verbs!

Numeracy:

In numeracy, Year 3 have been learning all about fractions. They started the week with equivalent fractions and even made their own fraction walls. They have then been finding fractions of some tricky numbers.

Year 4 have been investigating time graphs over the past week, they successfully collected the data and then plotted their own graphs! They are now moving onto tricky word problems involving adding, subtracting and multiplying!
