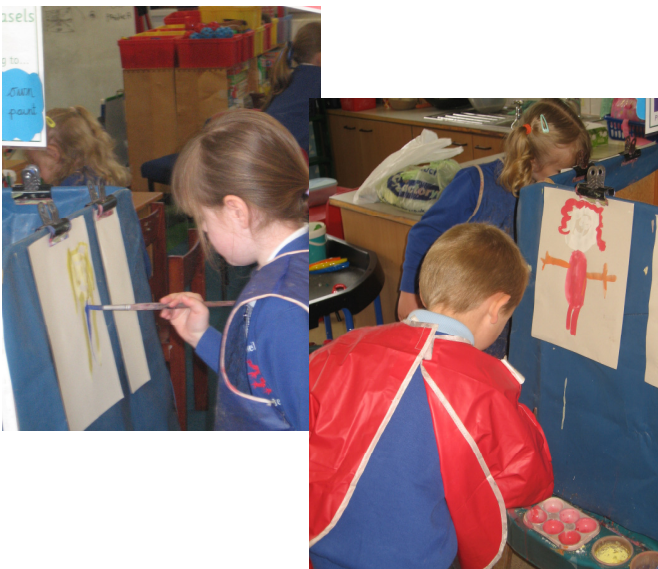


News from Foundation Stage

Mad about minibeasts

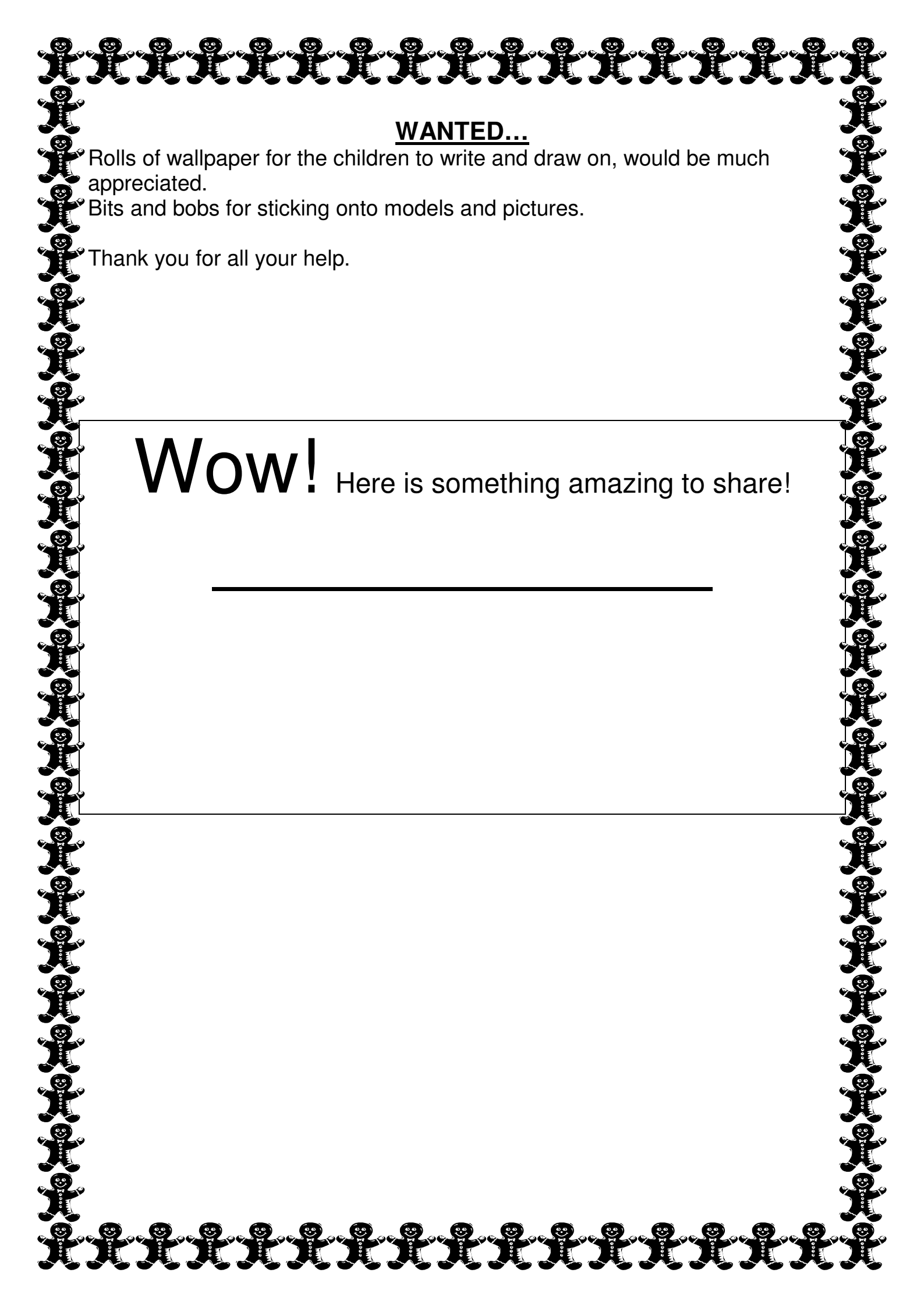
