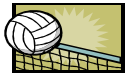


Year 1 Curriculum Information-Summer Term 2016

Welcome back to the Summer Term. Below is an outline of what we will be covering in the curriculum during this term. The children learn in the classroom, in the ICE Zone (the shared area), and outside.

Literacy 	We are starting the new term off with the genre; Fairy Tales. The children will be looking into stories in more detail, writing character profiles, comparing the villain to the hero/ine and much more. They will continue looking at; recognising, segmenting and blending CVC words and using these skills to write and read longer words, as well as preparing them for the Phonics Screening in June. The children will continue to have guided reading lessons and grammar lessons.
Numeracy 	Year 1 are going to be learning to tell the time using analogue and digital clocks. They will continue reading and writing numbers to either 50 or 100 in figures. They will use all previous learning to aid in Number stories that involve addition, subtraction, division and multiplication.
Science 	In our topic, Growing Plants, the children will be studying what plants need to survive and to grow healthy. This will involve a lot of practical work, by growing different plants and in different environments.
ICT 	The children have the use of laptops in the ICE zone for Blogging and research about Queen Elizabeth, in preparation for her birthday and about aspects of the seaside. Inside and outside the children will have the opportunity to use cameras for photographing activities.
Geography & History 	The children will be learning about the seaside. They will be using maps, looking at different landmarks and coastal regions. They will be comparing the seaside of today to that in Victorian times. The children will be researching about Queen Elizabeth and celebrating her 90th birthday.
P.E 	PE will take place on Tuesday afternoons. The children will continue practicing throwing, catching and batting skills in order to use in a game.

RE 	The children continue to learn about and compare Christians and Sikhs. This term they are looking at celebrations within the two religions.
Art & DT 	Andy Warhol will be the artist that the children are introduced to this term because they will be printing using seaside resources, such as; shells and seaweed. The children will be designing, making and evaluating pop up puppets which they will then use to create and perform a show.
