We wanted to find out what liquids we could use to make bubbles, apart from bubble mixture. We tried washing up liquid with water and liquid straight from the bottle. Then someone suggested milk, because we blow bubbles in that! So we investigated what happens when we put the bubble wands into milk... and it didn't work! We talked about why that was and then investigated a bit more. Then we found out that by mixing all the lovely ingredients together, we made fabulous bubbles, that made big white splats on the playground!

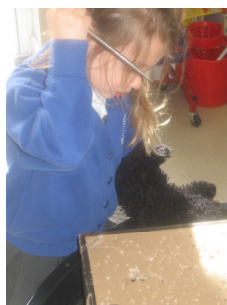

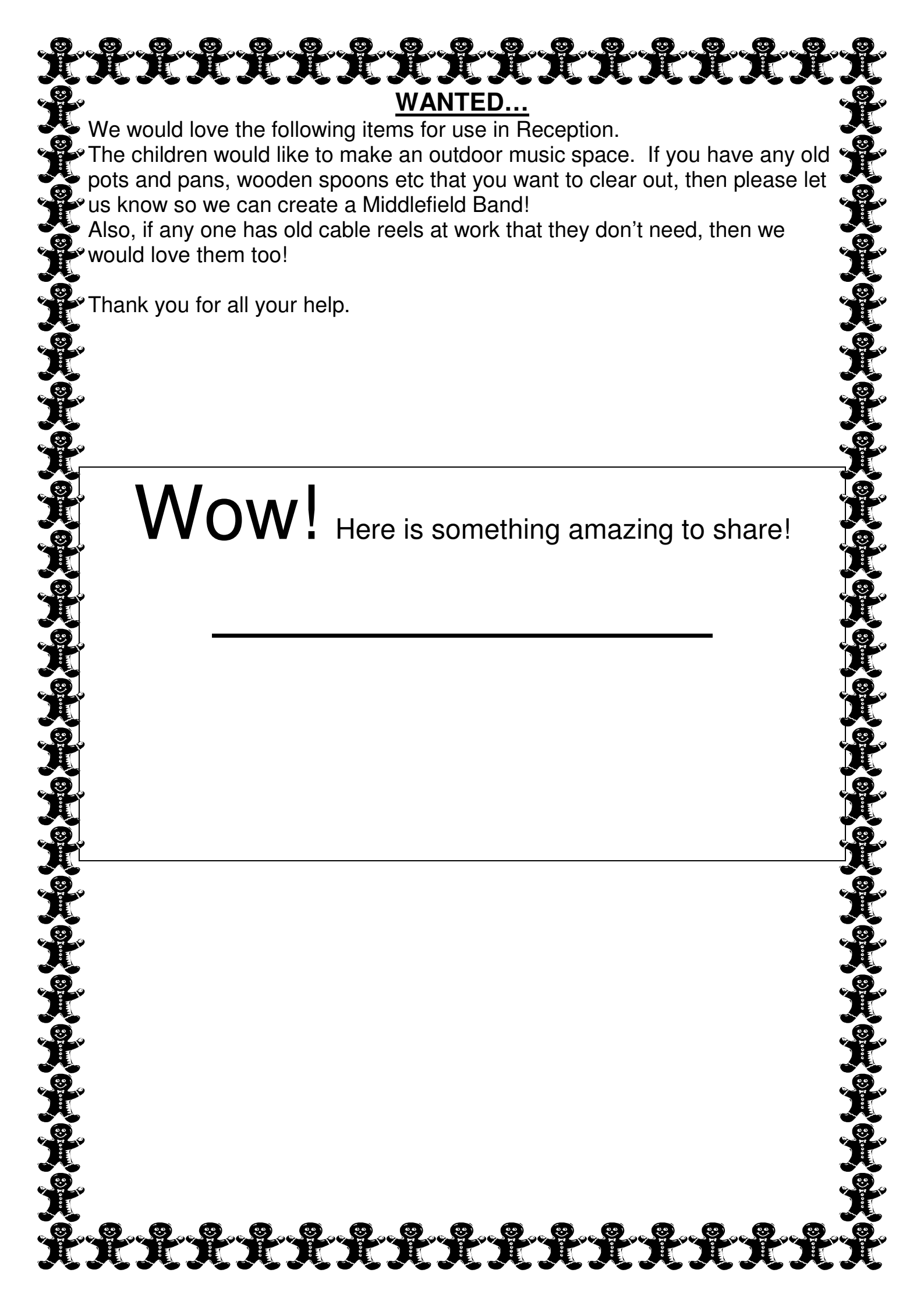
Easter Holiday happenings!
