Thanks for all the pictures and news from the break. The children loved sharing them with the class.

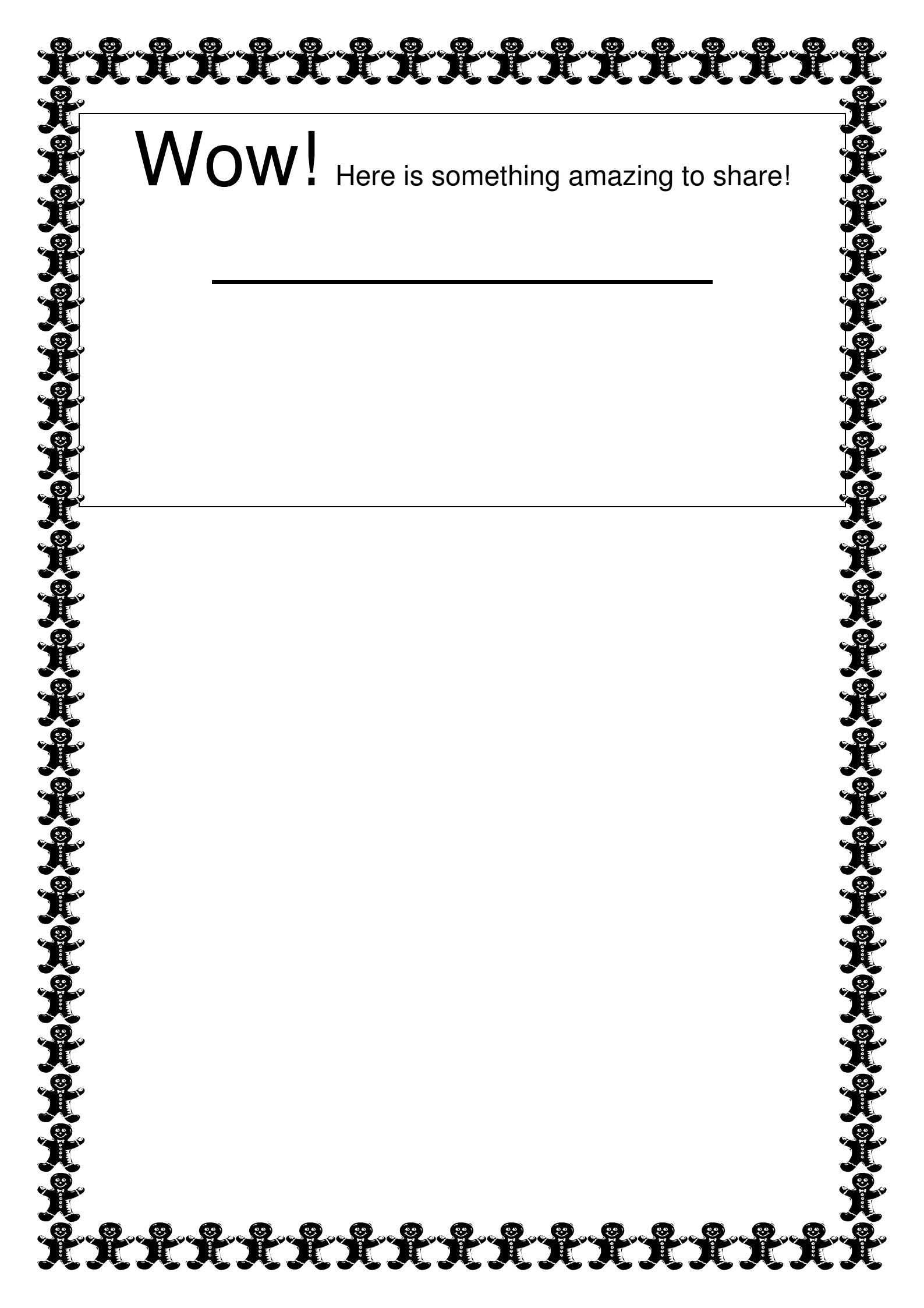
WANTED...
