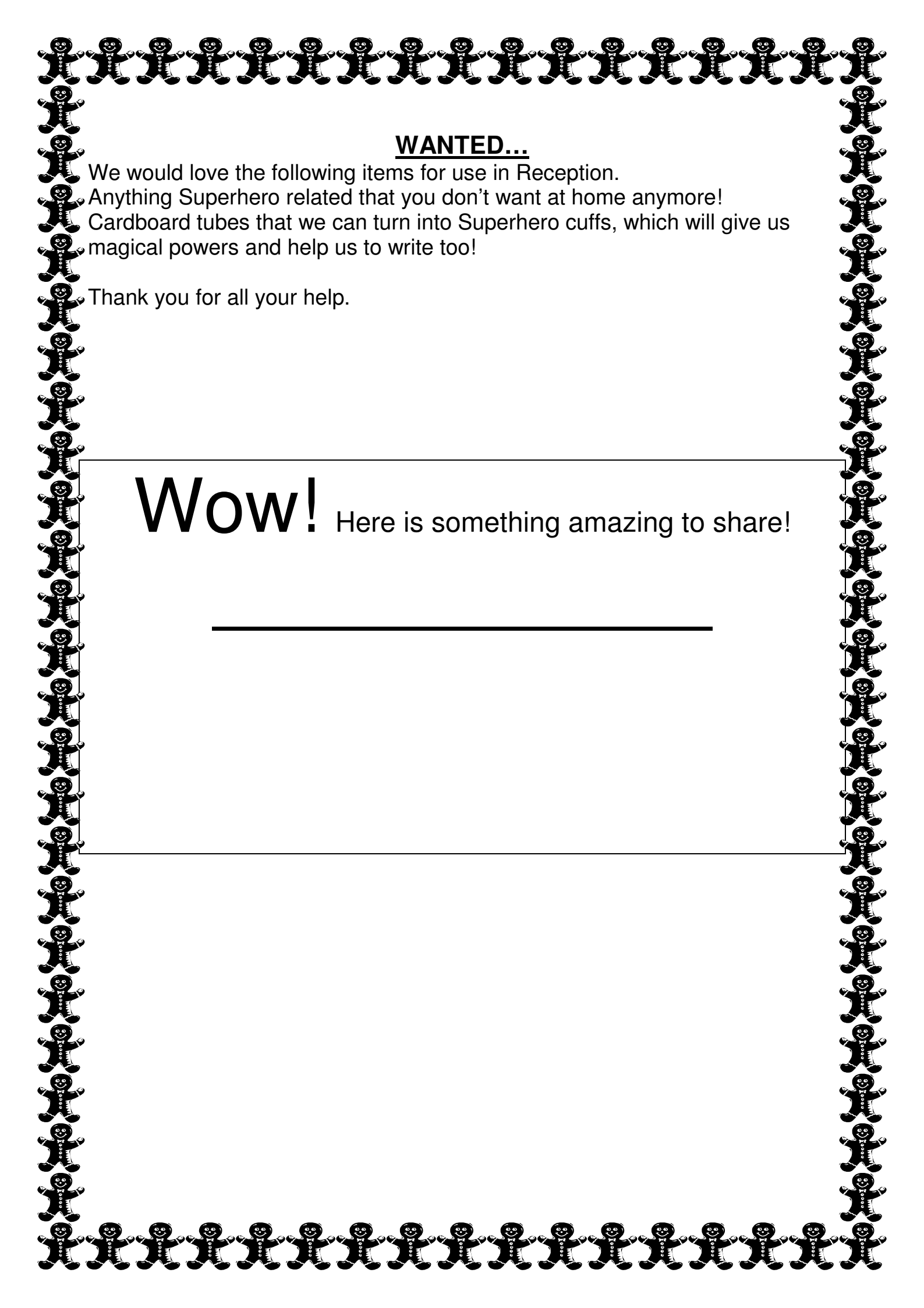
Pancake Week
