

## Year 1 Curriculum Information-Spring Term 2016

Welcome back to the Spring Term. Below is an outline of what we will be covering in the curriculum during this term. The children learn in the classroom, in the ICE Zone (the shared area), and outside.

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| <p><b>Literacy</b></p>        | <p>The children will be looking at; recognising, segmenting and blending CVC words and using these skills to write and read longer words. The children will continue to have guided reading lessons and daily phonics lessons. We will be studying Stories from other cultures and looking at non-fiction writing.</p> |
| <p><b>Numeracy</b></p>        | <p>The children will be reading and writing numbers to either 20 or 50 in figures.<br/>They will recall addition and subtraction facts for each number up to 10 or 20 and use number lines and hundred squares to identify number patterns on.</p>                                                                     |
| <p><b>Science</b></p>        | <p>In our topic, Materials, the children will be studying the properties of materials and their use. They will do this through a series of investigations both inside and outside of the classroom.</p>                                                                                                                |
| <p><b>ICT</b></p>           | <p>The children have the use of laptops in the ICE zone for Blogging and research about The Fire of London.<br/>Inside and outside the children will have the opportunity to use cameras for photographing activities.<br/>The "Bee-bots" will become fire engines and be out for programming.</p>                     |
| <p><b>History</b></p>       | <p>The children will be learning about The Fire of London.<br/>They will be looking at the order of significant events that took place during and after the fire, as well as enjoying their own bakery role play.</p>                                                                                                  |
| <p><b>P.E</b></p>           | <p>PE will take place on Tuesday afternoons this term. In these sessions the children will be learning fundamental movement skills that link to agility, balance and coordination. The children will also have Dance on Thursday afternoons which will also help to reinforce what has been taught in PE lessons.</p>  |
| <p><b>Art &amp; DT</b></p>  | <p>In art, the children will be colour mixing, learning about Primary, Secondary and Tertiary colours, then using their knowledge to paint collaborative pictures of The Fire of London.</p>                                                                                                                           |
