We had a great Fantasy day with all the children in Year 1 and 2 dressing up as a Fantasy character. Lots of wonderful work took place throughout the day.



Willow Wonders!

We had 'Fantasy Day' to kick start our Literacy genre; Fantasy Worlds. The children have started to produce some wonderful fantasy worlds of their own and thought about which objects would be needed in their worlds. In Numeracy, the children have been finding halves and quarters of an object and a quantity. Next week we will move on to measuring halves and quarters of liquids.

Cherry Champions!

The children returned after half term to find an area of the field roped off! There were strange burnt marks on the ground with sparkly red glitter amongst the ash. Further inspection found orange material caught on a tree.....The children reached the only sensible conclusion; an alien crash landed his spaceship on our field in the fog! Wonderful discussion and ideas lead to brilliant fantasy writing. When the children discovered that Explorer Bear was no longer in school the plot thickened. We think it may run for some time yet, as some aliens make an appearance next week!!

In Numeracy we have been calculating the 2, 5 and 10 times tables and making pictorial representations for multiplication number sentences. We have related this to working out amounts of money too. $5p \times 10 = 50p$ etc. Being able to count in 2s, 5s and 10s is an enormous advantage for this work; so we have been practising those skills.
