Dear Parents/Carers

Two years ago, St Neots Town Council granted the Freedom on the Royal Anglican Regiment 1st Battalion in recognition of their services to our country both at home and abroad. As a result, the Regiment is allowed the right to march through the town. On Tuesday 20th October, the Battalion will be marching through St Neots town centre and we have been invited to take our year 4, 5 and 6 children.

The march will begin at Huntingdon Street and continue through the High Street and on to the Market Square where the Regiment will halt in front of the dais where speeches will be given by civic dignitaries. The roads will be closed to all traffic, safety barriers in place along the route and Middlefield will be allocated a place within the schools section.

As this event is in the middle of the day, your child will need to bring a **packed lunch** to school with them – the children will have the chance to eat some of this before we go and the rest after we return to school.
