

Year 1 Curriculum Information-Autumn Term 2015

Welcome to the Autumn Term with Mrs Barnes. Below is an outline of what we will be covering in the curriculum during this term. The children learn in the classroom, in the ICE Zone and outside.

Literacy 	The children will be looking at; recognising, segmenting and blending CVC words, learning vowels and writing simple sentences, while studying Traditional tales. The children will also have guided reading lessons, and daily phonics lessons.
Numeracy 	The children will be reading and writing numbers to either 20 or 50 in figures. They will recall addition and subtraction facts for each number up to 10 or 20 and use number lines and hundred squares to identify number patterns on.
Science 	In our topic, Space, the children will be looking at what we need to survive and how these are dealt with in space travel.
ICT 	The children have the use of laptops in the ICE zone for Blogging and research about space. Inside and outside the children will have the opportunity to use cameras for photographing activities. The "Bee-bots" will be out for the children to have a go at some simple programming.
History 	The children will be learning about the explorer; Neil Armstrong. They will be looking at the order of significant space events as well as enjoying their own space role play.
Geography 	The children will be finding out what an explorer is. They will go on expeditions in the local area and research explorers from different regions on earth.
P.E 	This term, on Thursdays the children will be having Dance and Infant agility.
