We are able to offer tuition in the following instruments; Guitar Piano and Woodwind (Flute, clarinet, oboe, Saxophone, Bassoon) Group lessons are available, subject to sufficient numbers, and are suitable for beginners, as your child becomes more proficient on their instrument their teacher may recommend that they move to an individual lesson.

Prices per term are as follows (A term consists of 10 lessons during the term)

30 minute Group lesson	-	£65

If your child is absent on the day of the lesson unfortunately we are unable to refund any fees, however if we fail to provide a lesson due to teacher absence the lesson will either be made up or credited to your invoice the following term.
