



Literacy

This term in Literacy we will be focusing on learning our initial sounds. We will follow our phonics programme called: FFT Success for All Phonics. Children will learn a new GPC (sound) most days starting with:

s a t p i n

By the end of this term, children will have been taught 29 GPCs.

We will also be listening to and looking at a range of texts, including stories and other reading materials related to our 'All About Me' topic. We will be looking for the children to listen to and talk about the key ideas in the story. phrases and sentences that can be read by others.

Children will have lots of opportunities for mark making and will begin with drawing pictures, writing their name and will begin to learn how to form letters accurately.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will follow NCETM and White Rose units. This half term our learning will cover the following units:

- Counting
- Match, Sort & Compare
- Talk about measures and patterns
- Circles and Triangles

Our lessons will be fun, interactive and engaging involving lots of games, activities and singing and counting songs.

Communication and Language

We will be singing nurse rhymes and listening to stories, talking about our class routines, discussing how we use different things in the classroom and using the role play area. We will also focus on listening to and following instructions. We will also play lots of games that incorporate listening elements within them.



Understanding the World

This topic will enable us to learn more about the world around us. The area of learning covers topics such as people and communities, technology and the world. This term, to complement our topic of "All About Me", we will be exploring our new classroom and outdoor environment, learning about our bodies, how we grow and change as well as looking at people in our communities, and celebrations. We will also start looking out for the signs of Autumn and discuss celebrations around the world.



Expressive Arts & Design

We will be working on the following projects this term to help encourage the children's creative side.

Creating with materials- Self-portraits and pictures about our families. Halloween and Diwali inspired arts and crafts using a range of materials. Crafts based on familiar tales, like Jack and the Beanstalk and The Three Little Pigs

Being imaginative and expressive- Perform songs, rhymes, poems and stories to retell and role play with others

Physical Development

This term we will focus on moving and stopping, travelling in different ways and improving our spatial awareness. Additionally, children's gross motor skills will be developed through playing in the outdoor area and with the outdoor equipment. We will also take part activities to improve our fine motor skills ready e.g. dough disco.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

PSED is at the heart of what we do. We will talk about emotions and how to communicate about how we feel at school. We will take part in activities that will help us to build strong relationships with the people around us. We will have opportunities to develop the children's personal and social skills by talking about themselves and the people around them. We will also have lessons on how to help self-regulate and manage our own emotions within a school setting and at home. We will also talk about what makes us special and unique.
