## Preparing the pupils – Coronation 1953 costume ideas:

Very soon History Off the Page will visit your school for a Coronation 1953. To help you feel like a person from the time period, we recommend you put together a simple costume. Costumes do not have to be fancy – you can do a lot with clothes you already have! Here are some ideas:



### Girls' Costume

**Shirt:** A collared shirt with a tie, if possible.

**Jumper:** Grey or other dull colours are appropriate.

**Dress:** A dark skirt or pinafore dress.

**Footwear:** Socks and black or brown shoes, if possible. (Preferably not trainers.)

### Boys' Costume

**Shirt:** A collared shirt with a tie, if possible.

**Jumper:** Grey or other dull colours are appropriate.

**Shorts:** These should be dark (sports shorts would be fine.)

**Footwear:** Socks and black or brown shoes, if possible. (Preferably not trainers.)
