OUTDOOR LEARNING

The children will be learning outdoors as much as possible.

We will have snack time and lunch times outside if the weather is good.



LUNCHTIME

- EYFS and YR 5/6 bubble will eat in the hall (at different times)
- Tables and chairs will be wiped down after use.
- Yr 1, 2, 3 & 4 will eat their lunches in the classroom.
- Children having hot lunches will collect their lunch and take back to their classroom.
- Tables and chairs wiped down before the children eat in the classroom.
- Hand washing – before they eat, after they eat and when they come in, with warm soapy water.
- Children with hot meals will empty their waste into buckets in the ICE ZONES
- The children will be in zones on the playground.

Toilets

TOILETS

- Children will use their allocated toilets throughout the day.
- One child at a time.
- They will wash hands in the toilet basin before returning to the class.
- They will then wash their hands again in the classroom with warm soapy water or use sanitiser.
- Toilets will be cleaned after break, after lunch and after school.



END OF THE DAY

- One parent to collect their child at their classroom door by socially distancing on the playground. The teachers will see the children out. The lines are faded now, but reminder posters are dotted around the school grounds.



OFFICE



- The office will be manned- but please use email or phone in the first instance.
- Parents should come into the school building only when strictly necessary, by appointment only.
- They should wait to be called forward by the office staff, before entering the Foyer and maintain social distancing at all times.
- Visitors should avoid touching the doors and office ledge in the Foyer and use the hand sanitiser that will be available outside the building.
- Children should only enter school during their allocated arrival time and through their designated entrance.

Wrap Around Care



- We will be providing breakfast and after school club from 7.45am-6pm.
- This will be in the hall, not in the club room as previously.
- The children will be outside as much as possible.
- Food will be provided but with a reduced menu.
- **(Friday 11th September, club will only be till 4pm)**

Other Information

- We are discouraging the use of mobile phones with the children.
- Children will sanitise their hands-on entry to school. Frequent handwashing will occur in school so please practise this at home.
- PE starts from the first week back. The children can wear: joggers/leggings, school jumpers/cardigans, plain white t shirts, trainers/plimsoles.
- EYFS will bring their kit in on a Thursday so they can practise getting undressed/dressed.
- No need to bring book bags into school.
- EYFS will bring their kit in on a Thursday so they can practise getting undressed/dressed.
- Each child will have their own resources in a pack and they will be sitting facing the teacher in twos.
- All they will need to bring to school is a named water bottle, waterproof coat, wellingtons, packed lunch (if they are not having school lunch) and a sun hat if required. These must be brought in a named carrier bag - no rucksacks. A bag for life is perfect!
- Reception children to bring in a bag of spare clothes in a named carrier bag.
