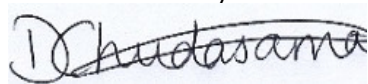
St Neots Food Bank are unable to accept any fresh goods, bread or flour products.

- Biscuits including chocolate biscuit bars.
- Toiletries (shower gel/shampoo)
