Due to new GDPR legislation we will no longer be sending the children's end of term and end of year reports home in the children's book bags unless we have your written consent to do so.

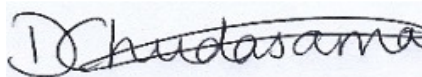
If you are happy for us to send the reports home with your child in their book bag please complete the attached form and return to the school office by Thursday 23rd May 2019.
