

Guide to Using My Passport

How do I collect my hours?

Make sure that you fill in your passport for every Children's University Learning Destination that you go to. Your activity leader will sign or give you a stamp or a sticker for your passport to show that you have attended. Your first 30 hours (Bronze Award) can be in one or more activities, and then you can continue to build your hours to gain further awards.

What is the back section for?

In the back section of your passport you can collect stamps and stickers for activities that you have taken part in, which are not part of the Children's University™; or include your 'Moments to be proud of'. This might be a trip out or a special award.

These stickers will not count towards your hours of learning but it is a great way of remembering them.



Where can I use my passport?

Most of the hours that you collect in your Passport to Learning will be for activities at school but we also want to celebrate learning which you do in other places.

You can use your passport anywhere that has been made a CU Learning Destination. Most CU Learning Destinations will have one of our black sticker or posters. If you are not sure if somewhere is a CU Learning Destination check the list on your school CU notice board or check on the Children's University website www.childrensuniversity.co.uk

- If you go somewhere that you think should be a Learning Destination get a CU nomination form from school and ask the Learning Destination to fill it in, then take it back to school or let us know by emailing Snsf_Coordinator@astrearnulf.org (please note underscore where space is)
