Reception Year - Contribution to School

In line with the other schools in the Trust we have decided once again to ask for an annual contribution of £10.00 for each child to cover visiting specialists and educational companies to the Academy. This means that parents are not inconvenienced by requests for small amounts of money at least twice a term.

This is where the contribution money was spent last year: History off the Page, Bhangra Dance and Dhol Drumming workshops, extra sports sessions, Dance Workshops, GenR8 assemblies and Zumba sessions. This charge also includes cost of ingredients for cooking and messy play. Due to recent cuts in funding, we would have been asking for small contributions for the above activities. We wish to continue this scheme and to enable us to make further bookings for the year a one-off contribution of £15.00 per child is now due. We are extremely lucky to have so many visitors to the school, which have mostly been subsidised by the Trust. Unfortunately, the amount of money we receive from the government per child is fixed until 2020 and yet our costs are increasing year on year. Without contributions from parents we will be unable to provide some of our existing activities without charging parents for each activity or we may have to cancel future visits.

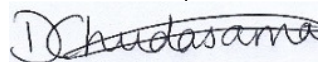

Please note that the annual contribution does not cover the cost of trips out ie. day trips and residential trips.
