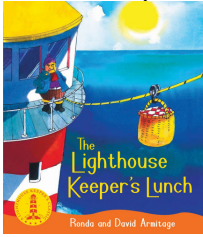
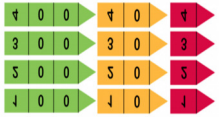


Year 2 Curriculum Information-Summer Term 2018

Welcome back to the Summer Term. Below is an outline of what we will be covering in the curriculum during this term, along with the children sitting their SATs in May. The children will be studying The Seaside in the inside and outside ICE Zone.

Literacy 	The children will be studying the story; The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch, discussing the techniques used by varying authors and using different styles to write their own 'Seaside stories'. In the ICE zone they will be writing holiday brochures, information facts about the seaside, writing postcards, as well as writing up experiments. Throughout their work they will be reminded to use all punctuation that has been taught in SPAG, as well as making their writing interesting and exciting.
Numeracy 	The children will be recapping all areas of Maths. They will be encouraged to use their preferable technique that has previously been taught, in order to add, subtract, multiply and divide. The children are moving away from using manipulative all the time to being able to visualise and record what is needed to answer the question. Maths will also be used across the curriculum - money in the role play area, measurement in the growth of their sunflowers, capacity and time in water activities, tally charts and graphs involving seaside animals and shape and pattern in art.
Science 	In our topic, Plants, the children will be recapping how plants with seeds grow and reproduce and understand the conditions seeds require in order to germinate. They will be studying the different methods plants use to disperse their seeds and throughout the term they will be carrying out an investigation by growing their own sunflower.
History & Geography 	The children will be learning about the seaside. They will be using maps, looking at different landmarks and coastal regions. They will be comparing the seaside of today to that in Victorian times.
ICT 	The children have the use of laptops in the ICE zone for research about Victorian and modern day seaside. Inside and outside the children will have the opportunity to use cameras for photographing activities.

P.E



PE will take place on Thursday and Friday afternoons. This term the children are fortunate enough to have cricket. They will be learning new skills and putting them into practice.

They continue to have athletics. They will explore running, jumping and throwing activities and take part in simple challenges and competitions. They will experiment with different ways of travelling, throwing and jumping, increasing their awareness of speed and distance.

Andy Warhol will be the artist introduced this term. They will be printing using seaside resources, such as; shells and seaweed.

The children will be studying different puppets, then making shadow puppets and designing, making and evaluating pop up puppets which they will then use to create and perform a show.
