

Year Six Curriculum Information- Summer Term 2018

Welcome back to Middlefield and a new year in Oak Class. Below is an outline of what we will be covering in the curriculum during this term.

Literacy 	This term year 6 are working for four weeks on various texts from previous SAT papers and answering 2/3 mark questioning using a point, evidence and explain method -quite a difficult task. We will then be looking at The Wonder Garden - and drawing out persuasive writing and creative writing from the text.
Numeracy 	This term year 6 will be revising all areas of Maths with a focus on how to answer reasoning questions which include money, weights and multi-step problems. We will be going through ratio and proportion and answering questions on recipes which require us to recalculate amounts of ingredients. This will be useful for our big bake which will be happening this term... dates to follow.
Science 	We will be describing how the Earth and living things have changed overtime. Looking at evolution and inheritance and also reproduction and Offspring. A letter will go out regarding SRE - Sex and relationship education which will be taught later in the summer term.
Geography 	We will be comparing our town to locations further afield. Scanning aerial maps, comparing rivers and researching deserts. We will also be finding out about different time zones.
Computing 	Continuing to use SPAG to improve our grammar knowledge but to also use coding to create a programme. We will be having e safety conversations relating to xbox, PlayStation etc and the advantages and disadvantages of social media. The technological age has had an impact on how we live day to day we will be talking about the changes each generation has faced.
Physical Education 	This term the children will be developing their skills in cricket, dance and field-based games. Every Tuesday children will have the opportunity to improve their throwing and batting skills. We will be attending swimming lessons later in the term if the local swimming pool has completed its refurbishment.
PSHE	We will be thinking about readiness for senior school and our move from Primary setting to a larger school. Looking at how relationships change overtime and discussing how we can develop

	new friendships.
Art 	We will be using e-resources to create pieces of art and will be building on a piece of art through receiving feedback from others. We will be able to present our art to the class and discuss how it was influence by famous artists.
Homework 	The children will continue with Maths Whizz at the start of this term. Aiming to complete 30 minutes a week with a Maths written task in addition. We will continue to use the CGP booklets this term. All year 6 children are expected to read for at least 15 minutes at home most days.
