Dear Parents of Children in Key Stage 2

Fruit for Key Stage Two Scheme

For some time now, children in Key Stage One have enjoyed fruit at morning break time. This is funded by the government.

Since 7th January 2008 we have offered children in Key Stage Two a piece of fruit at break time. Unfortunately there is no government funding available for this, however I have found a supplier who now provides us with fruit. The children usually have a choice of two types of fruit.

The scheme is run on a no-profit basis, and there is a small charge of 15p per day per child. **Due to parental request, we will now be running the scheme on a termly basis.** This will be £8.10 for the next full term, commencing Monday 8th January 2018 running until Thursday 29th March 2018. There is no charge for children entitled to free school meals.
