

School Uniform Reminder

Children need to have their P.E. kit, a pair of wellies and a waterproof coat in school at all times.

Please remember to send P.E. kit in on Monday and we will endeavour to get the children to bring it home for a wash on Friday.

Only plain stud earrings are allowed to be worn to school and these must be removed for P.E by the children themselves. If they cannot manage this, please can I ask you to take earrings out on the days your child has P.E.

As a reminder, the standard uniform consists of:

White or **blue** polo shirts (plain),

Grey trousers/skirt/pinafore with the length of skirt to be no shorter than just above the knee,

Grey or **white** socks,

Royal blue sweatshirt/cardigan (available from Orchard Clothing), **Royal blue** pullover or cardigan.

Summer alternative:

Grey shorts, **Blue and white** checked or striped dresses,

Black Footwear, Shoes (not trainers) if possible please, for school. If the children wear sandals they need to be flat, no flip flops please. Trainers for P.E.

Also a warm coat with gloves, scarf and hat are essential during colder months, a waterproof coat and a sunhat are required during summer months.

Please name every item of your child's school uniform.

Hair – all long hair to be tied back, so that your child's vision is not impaired. Girls and boys may wear gel, ponytails or hairbands, but no extreme fashion hairstyles please.

If they do not have their full PE kit/wellies or correct school uniform on more than three occasions throughout the term, they will not be allowed to come to school in their own clothes on the next reward day. It is really important that the children have their full P.E kit so that they do not miss out on the activities that we do at school and so they continue to learn to organise themselves well.
