On Wednesday 12th July, KS1 & KS2 will be participating in a Sports Science event run by Hunts Sports Partnership at Middlefield. Some of our year 5 and 6 children will be training to lead the children in these activities.

You are invited to take part for FREE after school on the same day. Hunts School Sports Partnership will run the event and give you the opportunity to see and take part in a range of FUN activities that support your child in Physical Education.

The activities use specialist equipment to develop agility, balance and coordination (the ABCs of sport) and include a "Batak Lights Out machine" which is often used by major Football Clubs to improve players' reaction time and speed stacking. The activities are varied, challenging and allow children to progress at their own pace, ultimately developing skills to support them to lead lifelong healthy lifestyles.
